**COMPENSATION:** Free room and board is provided for this unsalaried volunteer position.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** Responsible to the Camp Leader, who is supervised by the Program Director, the Chaplain, ordained or lay, provides spiritual support and leadership to campers and personnel. Working with the Camp Leader, the Chaplain leads (or helps) with the Jesus time and worship time. When ordained, the Chaplain celebrates the Eucharist; otherwise, will assist the Camp Leader to arrange for clergy to visit the camp once during the week to perform that service.

## REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- \* adult, or four years older than the oldest camper
- \* lay, or ordained qualification
- \* able to oversee education of campers in the Anglican faith and protocols
- \* evidence of sensitivity to the needs of young people with an ability to respond appropriately
- \* ability to work independently with minimal supervision and as a team member
- \* excellent communication, interpersonal, organizational and decision-making skills
- \*demonstrates enthusiasm, sense of humour, patience and self-control
- \* able to problem-solve using sound judgment
- \* physically and psychologically capable of carrying out the requirements of the position
- \* possesses vision, hearing and mobility sufficient to protect self and others in dangerous situations
- \* able to perform duties on a regular basis (i.e., good attendance)
- \* ability to respect and promote confidentiality
- \* satisfactory Criminal Record Check, Vulnerable Sector Search and Child & Adult Abuse Registry check

- \* experience working with young people
- \* education related to child development, or psychology
