POSITION SUMMARY: Reporting to the Camp Leader (supervised by the Program Director), the counsellor's responsibility is to facilitate the camper's development, happiness and safety. The counsellor "sets the stage" to allow campers to experience and discover new things with a sense of excitement. There is a focus on developing healthy relationships among campers that promote sharing, play and cooperative work.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- * adult, or four years older than the oldest camper
- * able to work within, and support, principles of the Anglican faith
- * able to show interest and enthusiasm for God's work by modelling a Christian lifestyle
- * ability to motivate campers to fully participate
- * evidence of sensitivity to the needs of young people with an ability to respond appropriately
- *demonstrates enthusiasm, sense of humour, patience and self-control
- * physically and psychologically capable of carrying out the requirements of the position
- * possesses vision, hearing and mobility sufficient to protect self and others in dangerous situations
- * able to perform duties on a regular basis (i.e., good attendance)
- * ability to respect and promote confidentiality
- * satisfactory Criminal Record Check, Vulnerable Sector Search and Child & Adult Abuse Registry check

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- * experience working in a faith-based organization
- * education related to child development, or psychology
